- 2.b. projects at the Weizmann Institute (since 1964)
- 2. German-Israeli Foundation (GIF):

bilateral research projects in a wide range of topics (since 1986)

- 3. German-Israeli Project Cooperation (DIP):
  - 4.a. interdisciplinary bilateral projects (since 1997)
  - 4.b. managed by DFG German Research Foundation (seit 2008)
- 4. Martin Buber Society of Fellows:

funding German and Israeli researchers in the Humanities and Social Sciences (since 2009)

## 5. Young Scientists Competition BMFTR Special Award:

The German Federal Ministry of Research, Technology and Space (BMFTR) facilitates study visits to Germany for awardees of the Israeli 'Young Scientists &Developers Competition' (since 2001), e.g. participation in the 'International Science Camp' (since 2017).
